## Mullet Boat Summer Series 2012

### Notice of Race and Special Sailing Instructions

1 **Rules**

These instructions shall be read in conjunction with the PCC General Sailing Instructions. If there is any conflict between these instructions and the General Sailing Instructions, then these instructions shall take precedence. Any notices to competitors (see General Sailing Instruction 8) will take precedence over both these and the General Sailing Instructions.

2 **Eligibility and entry**

This series is open to all Mullet Boats with a current racing certificate registered with PCC. To be eligible to compete in this series each skipper shall be a financial member of PCC.

3 **Briefing**

No briefing will be held. Direct any queries in advance to info@pcc.org.nz.

4 **Start times and divisions**

One division only. Days 1, 4, 5 start at 13:30. Day 2 start see Cruising Series Notice of Race, which become part of these instructions.

5 **Race schedule**

Day 1: 21 January (Mark Foy)  
Day 2: 27 January (Night race to Mahurangi)  
Day 3: 28 January (Forward hands race at Mahurangi)  
Day 4: 18 February (Upper Harbour Race)  
Day 5: 25 February (Wood Shield DYC)  
Day 6: 03 March (Taikata)

6 **Special sailing instructions and safety requirements**

7 **Courses and racing area**

Courses will be posted on the PCC notice board on the day of the race.

8 **Time limit**

The time limit will be at the discretion of the race officer, but no longer than 4 hours per race except days 2 and 5.

9 **Entry fee**

PCC members \$15 per day excluding day 4 which is payable to DYC.

10 **Scoring**

If fewer than 5 races have been complete a boat's series score will be the total of her scores. When 5 races or more have been completed a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

11 **Prize giving and prizes**

A prize giving will be held after each race in the PCC clubhouse approximately one hour after the last boat finishes except day 4. All crews are encouraged to attend. A representative from each boat should be present at the prize giving to be eligible for prizes. The Printing Express Line and Handicap Trophies will be awarded to the series winners.
