NOTICE OF RACE AND SPECIAL SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

1 - Rules

These instructions shall be read in conjunction with the PCC General Sailing Instructions. If there is any conflict between these instructions and the General Sailing Instructions, then these instructions shall take precedence. Any notices to competitors (see General Sailing Instruction 8) will take precedence over both these and the General Sailing Instructions.

2 - Eligibility and entry

This series is open to all Mullet Boats with a current racing certificate registered with PCC. To be eligible to compete in this series each skipper shall be a financial member of PCC. Boats must tow a dinghy capable of holding all crew when the start and finish line differ.

3 - Briefing

For 17 December race, briefing will be held in PCC Clubrooms at 6pm Friday 16th Dec.

4 Start times and divisions

One division only.

5 - Race schedule

Day 1: 26 Nov (Cruising Race) 1030hrs

Day 2: 03 Dec (Young Bucks) 1100hrs

Day 3: 10 Dec (Paremoremo) 1100hrs

Day 4: 17 Dec (Centreboard Cup) 1100hrs

6 - Special sailing instructions and safety requirements

7 - Courses and racing area

Inner Waitemata Harbour. Course details will be given to skippers on the race day.

8 - Time limit

The time limit will be at the discretion of the race officer, but no longer than 4 hours per race.

9 - Entry fee

PCC members \$20 per day

10 - Scoring

All races to count.

11 - Prize giving and prizes

A prize giving will be held after each race approximately one hour after the last boat finishes. All crews are encouraged to attend. A representative from each boat must be present at the prize giving to be eligible for prizes. The Lidgard Memorial Trophy will be awarded to the aggregate winner.
