1 - Rules

These instructions shall be read in conjunction with the PCC General Sailing Instructions. If there is any conflict between these instructions and the General Sailing Instructions, then these instructions shall take precedence. Any notices to competitors (see General Sailing Instruction 8) will take precedence over both these and the General Sailing Instructions.

6 - Special sailing instructions and safety requirements

Any vessels withdrawing from the race must notify Ponsonby Sport Radio (channel 77) or phone the club (09 376 0245) to notify the Race Officer.

7 - Courses and racing area

Start between Westhaven Tower and Westhaven buoy in easterly direction.

Round Rangitoto and Motutapu Islands to either port or starboard, Torpedo Buoy to Port to Finish between Westhaven Tower and Westhaven buoy in westerly direction.

8 - Time limit

Time limit will be 8 hours from the start of Div M
