NOTICE OF RACE AND SPECIAL SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

1 - Rules

These instructions shall be read in conjunction with the PCC General Sailing Instructions. If there is any conflict between these instructions and the General Sailing Instructions, then these instructions shall take precedence. Any notices to competitors (see General Sailing Instruction 8) will take precedence over both these and the General Sailing Instructions.

2 - Eligibility and entry

This series is open to all Mullet Boats with a current racing certificate registered with PCC. To be eligible to compete in this series each skipper shall be a financial member of PCC.

All races shall count towards the series points.

11 - Prize giving and prizes

A prize giving will be held after each race in the PCC clubhouse approximately one hour after the last boat finishes when the race starts and finishes at Westhaven. All crews are encouraged to attend. A representative from each boat must be present at the prize giving to be eligible for both race night and spot prizes. Series prizes will be awarded to first on line and first, second and third on handicap.
