NOTICE OF RACE AND SPECIAL SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

1 - Rules

These instructions shall be read in conjunction with the PCC General Sailing Instructions. If there is any conflict between these instructions and the General Sailing Instructions, then these instructions shall take precedence. Any notices to competitors (see General Sailing Instruction 8) will take precedence over both these and the General Sailing Instructions.

2 - Eligibility and entry

This series is open to all Mullet Boats with a current racing certificate registered with PCC. To be eligible to compete in this series each skipper shall be a financial member of PCC.

4 - Divisions

One division only.

8 - Time limit

At the discretion of the race officer, but no more than 4 hours per race.

9 - Entry fee

\$20 per day.

10 - Scoring

If fewer than 7 races have been complete a boat's series score will be the total of her scores. When 7 races or more have been completed a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

11 - Prize giving and prizes

A prize giving will be held on Day 5 in the PCC clubhouse approximately one hour after the last boat finishes. All crews are encouraged to attend. A representative from each boat must be present at the prize giving to be eligible for both race night and spot prizes.
