## NOTICE OF RACE AND SPECIAL SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

### 1 - Rules

These instructions shall be read in conjunction with the PCC General Sailing Instructions. If there is any conflict between these instructions and the General Sailing Instructions, then these instructions shall take precedence. Any notices to competitors (see General Sailing Instruction 8) will take precedence over both these and the General Sailing Instructions.

### 2 - Eligibility and entry

For eligibility and entry see PCC General Sailing instructions 2 and 3.

### 5 - Race schedule

**Every Thursday from 4th October except 20, 27Dec, 3 Jan. Joe "The Pipe" Clark Memorial Rum Race will take place on 11 April 2019**

### 6 - Special sailing instructions and safety requirements

No spinnaker or extras to be used. All headsails must be carried in normal forestay position and may be boomed out.

### 7 - Courses and racing area

The course will be selected from the 'Harbour Courses' listed in the current PCC handbook and displayed on the Westhaven start tower prior to the start.

### 8 - Time limit

The time limit will be 2.5 hours from the start of division 1.

### 9 - Entry fee

PCC members	\$20
Non PCC members	\$40

### 10 - Scoring

### 11 - Prize giving and prizes

A prize giving will be held after each race in the PCC clubhouse approximately one hour after the last boat finishes. All crews are encouraged to attend. A representative from each boat must be present at the prize giving or the prize will go to the next boat's representative present.
