## NOTICE OF RACE AND SPECIAL SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

### 1 - Rules

These instructions shall be read in conjunction with the PCC General Sailing Instructions. If there is any conflict between these instructions and the General Sailing Instructions, then these instructions shall take precedence.

Any notices to competitors (see General Sailing Instruction 8) will take precedence over both these and the General Sailing Instructions. Special Sailing Instructions will apply. Category 4 shall apply for keel boats and multi hulls. Mullet boats as per the PCC General Sailing Instructions.

### 2 - Eligibility and entry

For eligibility and entry see PCC General Sailing instructions 2 and 3. Special Sailing Instructions also apply.

**4 - Start times and divisions** - Competitors enter and sail under Host Club for NOR & Sailing Instructions. PCC host only Around Rangitoto Race.
