NOTICE OF RACE AND SPECIAL SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

1 - Rules

These instructions shall be read in conjunction with the PCC General Sailing Instructions. If there is any conflict between these instructions and the General Sailing Instructions, then these instructions shall take precedence. Any notices to competitors (see General Sailing Instruction 8) will take precedence over both these and the General Sailing Instructions.

2 - Eligibility and entry

For eligibility and entry see PCC General Sailing instructions 2 and 3.

3 - Briefing

No briefing will be held.

4 Start times and divisions (Mass Start)

1	Spinnaker (Women Only)	Purple

5 - Race schedule

<u>Race 1:</u> 1 Oct	<u>Race 4:</u> 12 Nov
<u>Race 2:</u> 15 Oct	<u>Race 5:</u> 26 Nov
<u>Race 3:</u> 29 Oct	<u>Race 6:</u> 10 Dec

6 - Special sailing instructions and safety requirements

6.1 Division 1: Boats 13 metres and under only one man shall be allowed on board. Boats over 13 metres may have up to two men on board. Men must not give any physical assistance after the five-minute signal for those divisions.

6.2 In the event of an emergency (situation where a collision or damage could occur) a

male on board may assist where normally only a woman is allowed to act. Should this occur the boat shall perform a 360 degree penalty as soon as possible after the emergency in accordance with the General Sailing Instructions.

6.3 A woman must helm.

7 - Courses and racing area

The course will be selected from the 'Harbour Courses' listed in the current PCC yearbook and displayed on the Westhaven start tower prior to the start.

8 - Time limit

Time limit will be 2.5 hours from Div 1 start.

9 - Entry fee

PCC members: \$20 per race / \$100 series
Non PCC members: \$40 per race / \$200 series
SERIES entry at discounted prices.

10 - Scoring

If fewer than 6 races have been completed a boat's series score will be the total of her scores.

11 - Prize giving and prizes

A prize giving will be held after each race in the PCC clubhouse approximately one hour after the last boat finishes. All crews are encouraged to attend. A representative from each boat must be present at the prize giving to be eligible for both race night and spot prizes. Series Prizes will be awarded.
