NOTICE OF RACE AND SPECIAL SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

1 - Rules

These instructions shall be read in conjunction with the PCC General Sailing Instructions. If there is any conflict between these instructions and the General Sailing Instructions, then these instructions shall take precedence. Any notices to competitors (see General Sailing Instruction 8) will take precedence over both these and the General Sailing Instructions.

2 - Eligibility and entry

This series is open to all "L" Class Mullet Boats with a current racing certificate registered with PCC. To be eligible to compete in this series each skipper shall be a financial member of PCC. Day 1 Boats must tow a dinghy capable of holding all crew.

3 - Briefing

No briefing will be held. Direct any queries in advance to info@pcc.org.nz.

4 - Start times and divisions

One division only. Day 1 start see Cruising Series Notice of Race, which become part of these instructions.

5 - Race schedule

6 - Special sailing instructions and safety requirements

A dinghy MUST be towed to and from Mahurangi race.

7 - Courses and racing area

Courses will be posted on the PCC notice board on the day of the race. Mahurangi Race, there and back.

8 - Time limit

The time limit will be at the discretion of the race officer.

9 - Entry fee

PCC members \$20 per day
Day 1 entry fee to DYC

11 - Prize giving and prizes

A prize giving will be held after the race hosted by PCC at the Clubhouse approximately one hour after the last boat finishes on Day 4 & 5. All crews are encouraged to attend. A representative from each boat must be present at the prize giving to be eligible for prizes. The Printing Express Line and Handicap Trophies will be awarded to the series winners.
