NOTICE OF RACE AND SPECIAL SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

1 - Rules

These instructions shall be read in conjunction with the PCC General Sailing Instructions. If there is any conflict between these instructions and the General Sailing Instructions, then these instructions shall take precedence. Any notices to competitors (see General Sailing Instruction 8) will take precedence over both these and the General Sailing Instructions.

2 - Eligibility and Entry

The age of skipper is to be recorded on the race entry form. Keelboats entering must be designed before 1978. Mullet boat skippers must be over 50 years of age and cannot be usual racing skipper.

To be eligible to win the Keith Hughes Trophy 'Oldest Skipper' entrants must record name and age of Skipper on entry form.

5 - Race Schedule

Race Day: Sunday 19 April.

6 - Special Sailing Instructions and Safety Requirements

Changes to Sailing Instructions will be posted in writing on the club notice board at least one hour before the first race. Code flag 'L' will be displayed from the club flagpole (ISAF 90.2(c)). Any notifications after that time will be communicated orally on VHF Channel 77. Flag code 'L' will be displayed from start tower.

7 - Courses and Racing Area

Courses will be selected from 'Harbour Courses' list within the 2019/2020 PCC Yearbook, and will be displayed on the Westhaven start tower prior to the race start. Note that there may be changes to courses raced between divisional starts.

8 - Time Limit

4.5 hours from the start of division 1

9 - Entry Fee

PCC members \$20

Non PCC members \$40

Entries Close 0900hrs on the Race Day

10 - Scoring

Race will not count towards Club points.

11 - Prizegiving and Results

Prizegiving will be held approximately one hour after the final race. All crews are encouraged to attend. A representative from each boat must be present at the prizegiving for both race and spot prizes.
